## The Fellowship of St Thomas

Is an ecumenical association to promote interest in and learn from the experience of the Churches in South Asia.



### Objects

- a) To learn from the experience and insights of the Churches of India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Burma, and to share these with the Churches in Scotland.
- b) To encourage corporate and private prayer for and with these Churches.
- c) To welcome visitors from South Asia.
- d) To encourage links between Christians in Scotland and Christians in South Asia.

## Activities

The Fellowship of St Thomas has an annual meeting at which Holy Communion is celebrated according to a liturgy of one of the Churches of South Asia.

The Annual Meetings usual take place in Dunblane in Central Scotland. As well as Holy Communion the AGM takes place and there are talks related to the objects of the Fellowship. We usually arrange to have an Indian style meal at a nearby restaurant.

A Newsletter is published twice a year.

Occasional local meetings may also be organised.

The St Thomas of India Unity Lecture is held every three years when a prominent Indian church leader is invited to speak on some aspect of the church's life in relation to church unity.

The next St Thomas of India Unity Lecture is scheduled for 2017. It is usually held in Edinburgh University in co-operation with the Centre for the Study of Christianity in the non-western world.
